Jelena Gačić Ivanov (1995) is a research assistant at the Faculty of Philosophy, University of Belgrade, at the Institute for the History of Art. She completed her undergraduate studies (2018) and master's studies (2019) with Prof. Dr Aleksandar Kadijević at the Department of Art History, Faculty of Philosophy, University of Belgrade. She defended her final master's thesis, entitled *Post-war Architecture in Kruševac (1945-2000)*, with a grade of 10. The aforementioned master's thesis was declared the best defended master's thesis at the Department of Art History, Faculty of Philosophy, University of Belgrade, by the Pavle Beljanski Memorial Collection in Novi Sad in October 2020. She defended her doctoral dissertation proposal, *The Life and Work of Architect Branislav Marinković (1903-1985)*, in June 2021, and was approved by the Teaching and Scientific Council. She is engaged in teaching the subjects *Architecture from the Renaissance to Postmodernism*, *Architecture in Serbia (late 17th – early 21st century)* and *Architecture in Serbia 1918–1941*, at the aforementioned Department. She is the author of several scientific papers, as well as a participant in two projects (supported by the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development) and five scientific conferences held in Belgrade, Niš and Leskovac.
