The 2030 Agenda Transformation Fund is a new fund, commissioned by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ).

It supports the efforts of partner countries to implement the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development by undertaking innovative activities in the following fields:

- 1 Aligning policies and processes with the 2030 Agenda,
- 2 Mobilising domestic resources and private investments for sustainable development,
- 3 Capacity building for monitoring and reviewing the 2030 Agenda.

What is funded?

The fund supports short-term, small-scale projects and activities to foster the implementation of the 2030 Agenda. Activities must be in line with the national priorities of the partner countries. They should contribute to achieving national goals for implementing the 2030 Agenda and be embedded in a broader political or social process in the country. Funding can, for example, be granted for studies, capacity development or events.

The funding structure is flexible. Funding of between EUR 50,000 and about EUR 125,000 can be granted for projects and activities covering a period of 4 –12 months.

Who can apply?

- Political partners or non-governmental organisations (NGOs) can submit an individual application for a financing agreement (political partners) or grant agreement (NGOs).
- State and non-state institutions and organisations in partner countries can also apply in conjunction with technical cooperation projects (GIZ projects).

How to apply?

All applications must be submitted via the → online application portal. Applicants will have to answer a series of questions regarding the project idea and upload a budget plan.

→ Applications can be submitted from 1 June to 31 July 2018
